
## Fall 2023 Calvary Reading & Prayer Guide The Acts of the Apostles

"You will be my Witnesses" (Acts 1:8)

OCT. 1-7	Acts 1-4	Ask for Christ's power to be a witness	
		within your family, at work/school, etc.	
<b>OCT 8-14</b>	Acts 5-7	Our sin hinders our witness. Ask the Lord:	
		"In my relationship with You, is there a sin	
		you want me to confess & turn from?"	
OCT. 15-21	Acts 8-10	Who is the "Saul" I am praying for?

OCT. 22-28	Acts 11-13	God sent Paul & Barnabas together to	
		witness. Pray for fellow witnesses to	
		support & encourage you.	
OCT. 29-NOV. 4	Acts 14-16	Our sin hinders our witness. The guidance	
		here is to "Keep ourselves from sexual	
		immorality." Pray for yourself & others to	
		gladly turn away from sexual & other sin.	

NOV. 5-NOV. 11	Acts 17-19	In his Athens witness, Paul cites poems of his era. Ask God: Show me how to use movies, music, books, etc. as I witness.
NOV. 12-17	Acts 20-22	Cultural gods are offended by Christ. How does our message of God's reign confront the gods of our own era?
NOV. 18-24	Acts 23-25	The Lord tells Paul, "Do not be afraid!" as a witness. This week, gladly hear God encouraging you the same way.
NOV. 25-NOV. 30	Acts 26-28	Paul continues to have Christ conversations all the way to the end. Pray for endurance as a witness to Christ!

## THEME: You are my witnesses" (Jesus in Acts 1:8)

A court witness is a person who sees an event, typically a crime or accident, and later tells what they saw.

Jesus called his followers "witnesses" to his resurrection. The apostles whom we are reading about saw the risen Jesus, and told others about their experience, and about the gospel of the kingdom (Acts 28:31). They invited others to trust and follow King Jesus along with them (Acts 2:38-39).

Now their message has been passed on through the centuries to us! May God bless you as you read The Acts. If you are a follower of Jesus, may you empower you to live for Jesus and to witness for him in your conversations with others! (Acts 8:1-12).
